Labour Market Developments

- Household Survey Development (HSD) project - ongoing work to introduce mixed mode collection to QNHS
- Population revisions arising from Census of Population 2016
- Examination of Sectoral Trends – in particular Agricultural sector – arising from 2009 sample
- Proposed revisions to NUTS Regional Classification



Labour Market Publications

- Quarterly National Household Survey (QNHS)
- National Minimum Wage estimates
- Other thematic publications
 - Detailed employment series
 - Households and family units



Upcoming Labour Market Developments

- Work to complete HSD project by end of year
- Census revisions and sectoral review to be completed
- Proposal to establish Labour Market user liaison group



Short-term Earnings Statistics

- Earnings, Hours and Employment Costs Survey (EHECS) continues to provide short term statistics on:
 - Earnings, Labour Costs, Hours worked and Employment



Historical Earnings Statistics

- Additional earnings statistics on Statbank
- Average industrial earnings & hours 1938 – 1999
 - Industrial sector, occupation, gender, age
 - Quarterly and annual averages
- Historical Earnings Publication 1938-2015
 - Combined data with existing data series & CPI



Structure of Earnings Statistics (SES)

- National Employment Survey 2003 - 2009
- Administrative data utilised for SES 2014
 - Revenue P35L
 - Census 2011
 - CSO Business Register
 - DSP Client Records System



Earnings Analysis using Administrative Data Sources

- Earnings statistics using Revenue P35L data
- CSO Business Register, 2011 – 2014
- Mean & Median Earnings
- Sector, Gender, Age Group, Nationality, Region



Public-Private Earnings Analysis

- Econometric analysis of Public-Private Earnings Differential
- Selection of model specifications
 - NES – 2003 & 2006
 - NES – 2007, 2009 & 2010
 - QNHS & P35L – 2011 to 2014



Upcoming Earnings Developments

- Structure of Earnings Survey (SES) - reference year 2017
- Based on Revenue's P35 file
- Employer and Employee survey
- Supplemented with administrative records
- Proposal to establish Earnings user liaison group
